Small and big kids can bump into each other	Pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> '- The playground is divided into two separate parts: playground 1 for small children (classes 1 to 5), playground 2 for bigger children (classes 6 to 9). '- There are at least two duty officers watching the kids at the playground at the school brakes. 			
Basketball hoops	Pupils, staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> '- Duty officer makes sure that the basketball hoops are in usable condition and if now, separates those at the back of the playground with a red tape. '- In windy weather the basketball hoops are placed down on the playground floor and secured with a red tape, so that pupils do not use them.
